The plastic case, similar to a CD case, opens out to make a stand so you can prop up one of the recipe cards on your counter for ease during cooking. The cases are reusable—next year I'll have calendar card sets both with or without the cases so you can buy a refill. Calendars are \$15 each. They make great gifts!
