Bellingham forum, walk to focus on "complete streets"

BELLINGHAM - A free forum and walk this week will explore "complete streets," or streets that accommodate people using various modes of transportation.

The event Wednesday, July 13, will begin at 6:30 p.m. with a roughly 45-minute presentation by planner Pete Lagerwey at the Pickford's Limelight Theater, 1416 Cornwall Ave. The theater has a capacity of about 75, so organizers will close it once it's full.

After the presentation, Lagerwey will lead a roughly 45-minute walk to key downtown streets and intersections. Lagerwey, who works at Toole Design Group, specializes in non-motorized projects, and he was recently project manager for developing and implementing the Seattle Bicycle Master Plan.
