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## Bellingham Farmers Market begins its winter season

The Bellingham Farmers Market is now entering its winter market phase, with about 70 vendors at the market each Saturday through Dec. 17.

The hours at during the winter market will be 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

"If you'd like to feature local poultry, beef, pork, or smoked salmon for your holiday meals, you'll find them here, as well as local cheeses, yogurt, and other dairy products," said Caprice Teske, market manager, in a press release.

Teske also noted other offerings include seasonal vegetables, fresh pasta, local teas, coffee and pastries. Non-edible items include soaps and lotions, jewelry, hats, purses and bags, pottery, pillows, cards, yarn and artwork.
