INNOVATIVE SOLUTIONS



Located in Ferndale, **Healthy Pet** is a company dedicated to providing natural and healthy pet food around the world. As members of Sustainable Connections, **Healthy Pet** worked with the Sustainable Business and Food & Farming programs to reduce dumpster waste by 83% and to help start a workplace CSA. In 2015, the Community Energy Challenge (CEC) assessed their 100,000 sq ft headquarters and created an Energy Savings Report highlighting opportunities to improve efficiencies from low-cost measures to capital building improvements.

The largest opportunity was a general lighting retrofit to replace the metal halide and fluorescent lighting fixtures with LEDs. **Healthy Pet** agreed, and local companies 2020 LED and Aperture Electrical won the job to replace the 533 fixtures. Creating the design, 2020 LED decided to use tunable LEDs to simulate natural daylight and improve employee safety, happiness and productivity.

The project is the CEC's biggest to date, saving 517,724 kWh of electricity and \$43,776 annually. That is enough electricity to power 54 homes! A large rebate from Puget Sound Energy funded nearly half of the project.

As a result of this project and many other sustainability focused achievements, **Healthy Pet** won the 2016 Northwest Clean Air Agency Platinum Award for achieving the highest standards of air quality compliance and sustainability. Congratulations **Healthy Pet**!
