Disaster Recovery Dislocated Worker Grant

The Disaster Recovery Dislocated Worker Grant helps businesses address employment gaps related to the extra recovery work needed following the recent flooding in Whatcom and Skagit counties in December 2025.

You can employ temporary workers* and have their wages paid.

- Construction & Repairs: Rebuilding and structural repairs.
- Trade Services: Electrical, plumbing, and HVAC restoration.
- Residential & Commercial Clean-up: Removing mud, drywall, flooring, and appliances from flooded homes and businesses.
- Debris Removal: Clearing debris, trees, and damaged household items.
- Specialized Services: Home elevation and mold mitigation.

*Eligibility required. Some restrictions apply.
