The latter allows you to define accounts with specific budgets (e.g. by manager or program such as holiday bonuses, welcome or anniversary gifts, survey incentives, and beyond) and authorize access to those funds.

Corporations can set the expiration date of the Gift Card and unspent card money will be returned to you, less a 10% restocking fee.

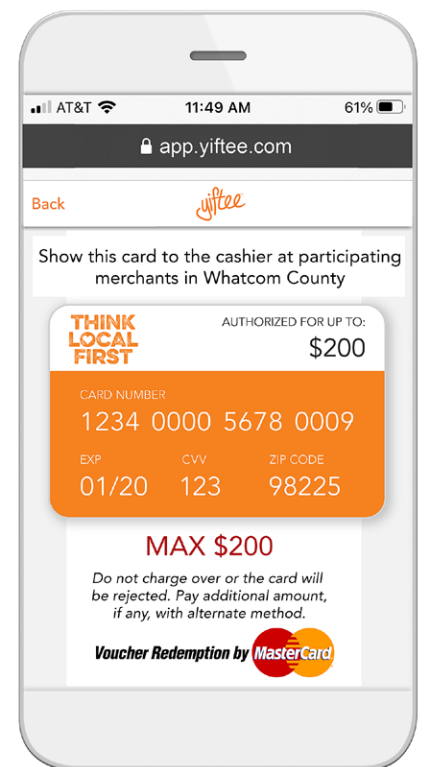
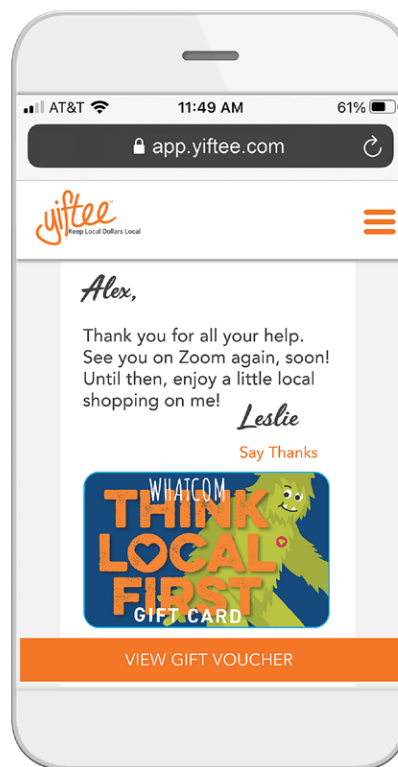
Comprehensive reporting gives you visibility into givers, recipients, spending, refunds, redemption, information and more.
